The guidelines for freezer storage are for quality only--frozen foods stored continuously at 0°F (-18°C) or below can be kept indefinitely. Looking for a specific item?

Foods that require refrigeration should be put in the refrigerator as soon as you get them home. Stick to the "two-hour rule" for leaving items needing refrigeration out at room temperature.
