

How has the global economic downturn impacted Albania's tourism sector?

A robust recovery in 2021 and early 2022 was slowed by the pandemic-induced global economic downturn. Strong foreign investment inflows have since helped Albania's tourism sector to expand, however, and it is now posting stronger growth figures than many of its peers.

How has the Albanian labour market changed over the past decade?

The Albanian labour market has seen improvement over the past decade, with steady increases in labour force participation and employment, and a gradual decline in unemployment (Figure 46).
